Goals

- To make donations to the School, to help fund development and facilities which will promote excellence and innovation

Focus

The initial focus was to build a decent capital financial base. The first members of the Foundation provided over \$400,000 within five years.

Some of its contributions:

- provided loan finance for the construction of major new buildings
- provided the first set of computers for the School
- offered a substantial loan towards the construction of the senior teaching centre completed in 1994
- made a cash gift of \$25,000 and a substantial loan for the construction of The Medbury Centre
- financed the purchase of prizes for the annual Prize Giving
- funded The Medbury School Foundation Building.





Future

The financial future of the Foundation is dependent on:

- Having a balance between investment of funds, and provision of funds for development within the School
- Increasing the `member' base of the Foundation, and consequently its financial support for the School

The work and funding from the Medbury School Foundation, continues to be, literally, a `foundation' for the School.
